

Study Plan Guidelines

for students of the MSc Economics and Development

March 2026

Between March 26 and April 21, 2026, as a student of the MSc Economics and Development you should submit a study plan if you are a first-year student, or a second-year (or beyond) student who has not done so yet, or if you want to modify the most recent study plan you have previously submitted.¹ In your study plan you will specify your choices of non-mandatory courses – please find [here](#) (in Section 8) the contents of the courses in the MSc Economics and Development.

Study plan submitted through Servizi Online You can (and should) use [Servizi Online](#) to submit your study plan if you enrolled in the MSc Economics and Development for the first time in a.y. 2024-25 or 2025-26. [This page](#) provides instructions concerning the online procedure, including a pdf guide called “submission guide” and a video tutorial (in Italian). Some students select elective/optional courses for more than 12 ECTS, but notice that for these courses, 12 ECTS suffice. Please contact the person in charge of study plans² if you need assistance.³

- On March 30, at 11am in room D5/001, professor [Gianna Giannelli](#) will offer orientation about choices of non-mandatory courses for the students of the curriculum Development Economics and will be available to answer questions.
- On March 30, at 4pm in room D6/015, professor [Annalisa Luporini](#) will offer orientation about choices of non-mandatory courses for the students of the curriculum Economics and will be available to answer questions.

Study plan submitted in paper form You need to submit your study plan in [paper form](#) if you enrolled for the first time in the MSc Economics and Development in a.y. 2023-24 or earlier, or if in the past you have submitted a study plan in paper form, or if you want to insert a PEP course in your study plan (please find [here](#) information on PEP courses).

- Please download the form from [this page](#): go to the line Economics and Development (LM) and click on – say – 2023 if you enrolled for the first time in the MSc Economics and Development in a.y. 2023-24.
- Fill in the form following the instructions [here](#) for the curriculum in Development Economics, [here](#) for the curriculum in Economics, [here](#) for the track in Behavioural Economics. Please pay attention to fill in [every field](#); the ECTS must add up to at least 120. Most of the “codici” you need can be found [here](#).⁴
- Send by email the filled in form to the person in charge of study plans (see footnote 2), who will check it and contact you in case some amendments are needed.
