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## SECTION 2 – BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF RESEARCH PROJECT

*The project explores the impact of labour demand variations on internal emigration decisions at local level in Italy. The project relies on a unique dataset on job postings at provincial level which allows to conduct empirical analysis at a disaggregated provincial level. The project will also dig deeper on the channels through which the impact of labour demand shocks on internal mobility manifests itself: Do labour demand shocks affect local real wages which in turn attract workers from other provinces? Do workers move because of the gap in terms of employment opportunities between origin and destination?*

### Objectives

After the research assistantship, the student will be able to:

- *Performing statistical analysis and data cleaning using Stata.*
- *Write a critical review of the scientific literature on an advanced topic.*
- *Manage and analyze a large panel dataset.*
- *Interpret and present the results of an econometric analysis in a professional manner.*

### Main Tasks for the Research Assistant

- *Literature review; identifying and filing the most relevant papers in the literature*
- *Cleaning and merging of different datasets; creation of variables of interest.*
- *Performing descriptive statistical analyses; estimating regression models under the supervision of the professor.*
- *Preparation of graphs, maps, and tables to visualize the results; contribution to the drafting of the methodological section of a research report.*

### Tools and Methodologies

### Tentative Schedule of the Student's Work

- *Stage 1 (Month 1): Literature review and bibliography on the most relevant contributions of relationship between internal migration and selected labour market indicators;*
- *Stage 2 (Months 2): Data work; descriptive data analysis; Monte Carlo simulations*
- *Stage 3 (Months 3): Creating and estimating econometric models under the supervision of the professor; interpretation of the results.*
- *Stage 4 (Month 4): Writing of a report about the results of stage 3, including graphs and tables.*
