Study Plans Instructions

for students in the MSc in Economics and Development.

(this version: November 2021)

As a UniFi student you need to compile and submit a Study Plan (Piano di Studi) in which you specify which elective courses you will take (an overview of information on possible choices and courses can be found here).

Study Plans are entered and modified on-line using the <u>SOL portal</u> during a specific period of each academic year, using your usual UniFi web credentials. <u>This page</u> has general instructions concerning the on-line procedure, including a pdf guide and a video tutorial (in Italian).

There are however cases in which you have to resort to the paper form:

- 1. if you enrolled for the first time before 2020/2021 and need to fill in or modify your plan;
- 2. if you already have filled in a paper plan in the past and need to modify it.

If you need to resort to paper form, read the following guidelines.

1. Study plan to be compiled for the first time:

- download the form here;
- compile following the rules found <u>here</u> for the curriculum in Development, <u>here</u> for the curriculum in Economics, <u>here</u> for the track in Behavioural Economics);
- <u>fill every field</u> (the credits must add up to 120); most of the "codici" you need can be found <u>here</u> or <u>here</u>.

2. Modifying an existing Study Plan:

- download the form <u>here</u> and fill it in thoroughly.

You then need to contact the person in charge of study plans (<u>Leonardo Boncinelli</u> for the curriculum in Development Economics, <u>Annalisa Luporini</u> for the curriculum in Economics including the track in Behavioural Economics) who will check the form and sign it.
