

Study Plans Instructions

for students in the MSc in Economics and Development.

(this version: November 2020)

As a UniFi student you need to compile and submit a Study Plan (Piano di Studi) in which you specify which elective courses you will take (an overview of information on possible choices and courses can be found [here](#)).

Study Plans are entered and modified on-line using the [SOL portal](#) during a specific period of each academic year, using your usual UniFi web credentials. [This page](#) has general instructions concerning the on-line procedure, including a pdf guide and a video tutorial (in Italian).

There are however cases in which you have to resort to the paper form:

1. if you enrolled for the first time before 2017/2018 and need to fill in or modify your plan;
2. if you already have filled in a paper plan in the past and need to modify it.

If you need to resort to **paper form**, read the following guidelines.

1. Study plan to be compiled for the first time:

- download the form [here](#);
- compile following the rules found [here](#) for the curriculum in Development, [here](#) for the curriculum in Economics, [here](#) for the track in Behavioural Economics);
- fill every field (the credits must add up to 120); most of the “codici” you need can be found [here](#) or [here](#).

2. Modifying an existing Study Plan:

- download the form [here](#) and fill it in thoroughly.

You then need to contact the person in charge of study plans ([Leonardo Boncinelli](#) for the curriculum in Development Economics, [Annalisa Luporini](#) for the curriculum in Economics including the track in Behavioural Economics) who will check the form and sign it.
